Following a request received from an interested party, the Commission for Communications Regulation (ComReg) has today extended the deadline for the submission of responses to its current public consultation on the liberalisation of the 900 MHz and 1800 MHz bands (ComReg Document 09/99) to 5:00 pm on 26 February 2010.

The consultation addresses issues such as the expiry of existing GSM licences, and consults further on the details of ComReg's proposed auction format for the future release of spectrum and the conditions that will apply to future licences in these bands.

ComReg welcomes the views and comments of all interested parties on the issues raised in Document 09/99 (Liberalising the Future Use of the 900 MHz and 1800 MHz Spectrum Bands - Response to Consultation 09/14 & Further Consultation).
