## 19 Deflector Licences Issued Regulator announces final licensing round

The Director of Telecommunications Regulation, Etain Doyle today (7<sup>th</sup> April 2000) announced that she has now issued 19 deflector licences under the licensing framework announced in November 1999 (see details attached). She also issued a licence to South Coast Community Television in December in response to an earlier application.

The Regulator also announced details of application procedures to apply for further licensing of television deflector operations. Further information and licence application forms are available from the ODTR.

She said " I am aware that there remain a number of deflector operators who did not avail of the opportunity to apply for licences. In operating without a licence they are in breach of the Wireless Telegraphy Acts. As there appears to have been genuine difficulties affecting some of these I have decided therefore to provide a further opportunity for such groups to regularise their position. I will accept and deal with any applications, which are forwarded to me before 4<sup>th</sup> May 2000. Such applications will be considered on the same basis as before. This will be the final opportunity to apply for licences – there will be no further licensing rounds."

Commenting on the licensing framework for deflectors the Regulator said, "I am pleased that the process which I provided was capable of meeting the requirements of applicants in nearly all respects. Licensing was made possible only after detailed work on legal aspects surrounding television retransmission licensing."
