- 2. To submit a complete application, it is necessary:
 - to complete all sections of the Application Form and
 - to submit the full licence fee with the application

An application cannot be processed until ComReg has received a complete application.

3. All Amateur Station: Special Event Licences shall incur a fee of €30.

Licence Amendments shall incur a fee of $\mathfrak{G}0$

- 4. Special Event Licences are only granted for a specific period and expire thereafter. If the amateur running the Special Event wishes to continue to use such a Station, a new application must be submitted to ComReg.
- 5. Prior to completing an application, applicants are advised to read document ComReg09/45 Amateur Station Licence Guidelines.
