ComReg accepts dispute resolution request from Verizon¹

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¹ Regulation 31 of the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Service (Framework Regulations) 2011¹ sets out that, in the event of a dispute, ComReg shall, at the request of either party, initiate an investigation of the dispute and make a determination aimed at ensuring compliance with the obligation relevant to the dispute.



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ComReg received a request for dispute resolution from Verizon Business on 28th September 2011 regarding Eircom's cease notice period for services in Ireland.

The scope of the dispute is a potential refusal by Eircom to negotiate in good faith with Verizon Business in respect of the cease period for certain regulated products contained in the market for the terminating segments of wholesale leased lines².
