The Commission for Communications Regulation (ComReg) today announced the outcome of Phase 1 of the Third Party Business Radio Licensing Scheme.

The Third Party Business Radio Scheme is a new flexible licensing scheme aimed at companies interested in providing two-way business radio services to third parties. The new scheme offers licensees the opportunity to provide a wide range of mobile business radio services, on a national basis. Business radio services are widely used by taxi, security, courier and transport companies to provide instant communication of voice or data between personnel.

The Chairperson of ComReg, Isolde Goggin said: "We are very pleased at the level of interest shown in this licensing scheme. It will provide added flexibility to the business radio community to develop services which can be offered to their customers throughout Ireland."
