## **ComReg extends deadline for responses to a consultation on the liberalisation of the GSM bands**

The Commission for Communications Regulation (ComReg) has today announced that, following requests from interested parties, the deadline for the submission of responses to its current public consultation on the liberalisation of the GSM bands (ComReg Document 08/57) has been extended to September 30, 2008.

The consultation deals with the liberalisation of the GSM 900 MHz and 1800 MHz Spectrum Bands, the options available for making further spectrum available as well as the expiry of current operator licences.

ComReg welcomes the views and comments of all interested parties on the issues raised in Document 08/57 (Consultation - Liberalising the Use of the 900 MHz and 1800 MHz GSM Bands) which is available on the ComReg website [www.comreg.ie](http://www.comreg.ie).
