# 1 Extension of Response Period

1. Following a request received from two interested parties, the Commission for Communications Regulation (**ComReg**) has today extended the deadline for the receipt of submissions to its consultation on *Spectrum Award - 2.6 GHz band with possible inclusion of 700 MHz, 1.4, 2.3 and 3.6 GHz bands* (ComReg Document 14/101) to **5 pm, 14 November 2014**.

4. We would request that electronic submissions be submitted in an unprotected format so that they can be included in the ComReg submissions document for electronic publication.

In order to promote openness and transparency, ComReg will publish all respondents' submissions to this consultation as well as all substantive correspondence on matters relating to this document, subject to the provisions of ComReg's guidelines on the treatment of confidential information<sup>1</sup>. In that regard, respondents are requested to provide both a confidential and non-confidential version of their submission to the consultation, providing supporting reasoning as to why they consider material to be confidential. Alternatively, respondents are requested to place confidential material in a separate annex to their response, again providing supporting reasoning in that annex as to why such material is confidential.
