ComReg hosts seminar for the Business Radio sector

The Commission for Communications Regulation (ComReg) today hosted the first in a series of industry seminars for companies and firms who supply and install radio telecommunications equipment.

The Business Radio Sector includes companies who supply and install radio telecommunications equipment - such as two-way radios - to courier firms, taxi companies and the construction and security industries, among others.

ComReg is the agency responsible for issuing licences for two-way radio systems in Ireland. The purpose of the seminar was to increase awareness of these services among the Business Radio community. The seminar also covered new developments in radio and ComReg's electronic licensing initiative.

David Gunning, Director of ComReg's Market Operations Division said: "By sharing information with the Business Radio sector, ComReg can improve the standard of service that is given to its stakeholders. ComReg is encouraged by the excellent response to this initiative and we plan run a series of these seminars throughout the country."
