## **ComReg wins Human Resource Development Award**

ComReg has been awarded the 2004 Irish Institute of Training and Development (IITD) national award for human resource development in the public services category. This award celebrates organisations in Ireland that demonstrate best practice and an ongoing commitment to human resource development and this is second occasion in three years that we have won this award, having also achieved it in 2002.

Shay O'Malley, ComReg's Human Resources Director said that "ComReg operates in a dynamic, complex environment and our capacity to integrate our human resource development strategies with the strategic goals of the organisation is central to our overall effectiveness. We recognise that excellent performance can only be achieved through ongoing investment and commitment to our staff".

This is the third major HR Award won by ComReg in the past year - in September 2003, it was awarded the Institute of Engineers of Ireland (IEI) award for Continuing Professional Development (CPD) and, in November 2003, it was successful in renewing the "Excellence Through People" national standard.
