Industry meeting regarding the maximum Call Handling Fee permitted for handling emergency calls for the period 12th February 2011 to 11th February 2012

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Industry meeting regarding the maximum Call Handling Fee (“CHF”) permitted for handling emergency calls for the period 12th February 2011 to 11th February 2012.

Under Section 58B of the Communications Regulation (Amendment) Act, 2007 (‘the Act’) BT Ireland is the designated Emergency Call Answering Service (‘ECAS’) operator, appointed by the Minister of the Department of Communications, Energy and Natural Resources on 12th February 2009.

In line with Section 58D of the Act, ComReg has completed its review of the maximum permitted CHF that the ECAS operator can charge for handling emergency calls.

In accordance with Section 58(H)(4) of the Act, all undertakings that will be affected by Section 58H(2) of the Act are invited to attend a meeting to be held on **Monday 10th January 2010** at a location and time to be arranged by ComReg.
