Acceptance of BT request for dispute resolution relating to LLU collocation at Eircom Nutley Exchange

The Commission for Communications Regulation ('ComReg') has today decided to use the dispute resolution procedures under Step 2 (b) of the Dispute Resolution Procedures set out under ComReg decision notice D18/03, to resolve a dispute from BT Ireland ('BT') regarding a matter that has arisen between BT and Eircom Limited ('Eircom') in relation to BT's request for LLU collocation at the Eircom Nutley Exchange.

On 6th July 2007, BT submitted a request for dispute resolution to ComReg to determine whether Eircom was acting in breach of its obligations under D8/04 by refusing to provide BT with the LLU exchange capacity they requested on the Eircom Main Distribution Frame in the Nutley Exchange.

ComReg notified Eircom of the dispute on 26th July 2007 as per the Dispute Resolution Procedures Step 2 under ComReg decision notice D18/03.

The Scope of the dispute is limited to the LLU collocation obligations, including but not limited to those under D8/04 and BT's request to Eircom for LLU collocation exchange capacity on the Eircom Main Distribution Frame in the Nutley Exchange.

ComReg has up to four months from the date of acceptance of the dispute to issue its final determination.
