 Following a request received from an interested party, the Commission for Communications Regulation ('ComReg') has today extended the deadline for the submission of responses to its current public consultation on the 'Postal Regulatory Framework: Implementation of the Communications Regulation (Postal Services) Act 2011'(ComReg document 12/38) to 5:30 pm, on Monday 11 June 2012.

- 2. This consultation sets out ComReg's proposals as to how postal service providers should be authorised and the rights and obligations which should attach to such authorisations. The consultation also addresses the set of universal postal services that An Post, as the "universal postal service provider" designated by the Oireachtas, should be required to provide.
