The Commission for Communications Regulation (“ComReg”) is holding a meeting to present the summary of its Consultation 13/58 entitled; *“Electronic Communications:-Proposed Measures to ensure equivalence in Access and Choice for Disabled End-Users”*.
2. ComReg’s presentation will be limited to the contents of its published summary consultation paper 13/58a.

ComReg also wishes to note that it has been advised of three mobile service providers offering facilities for end-users using pay-as-you-go tariffs for their mobile telephones to top-up credit on their mobile telephones by way of SMS.¹ This is additional information in respect of paragraph 57 and footnote 17 of ComReg consultation document 13/58.
