Closure of the investigation regarding the dispute between BT Communications Ireland Limited and Eircom Limited in relation to Eircom Limited's alleged unauthorised price change to the Main Link Access charge in Partial Private Circuit End User Links.

On 19 March 2009 BT Communications Ireland Limited (“BT”) informed the Commission for Communications Regulation (“ComReg”) of the withdrawal of its request for Dispute Resolution regarding a dispute between BT and Eircom Limited (“Eircom”) in relation to Eircom’s alleged unauthorised price change to the Main Link Access charge in Partial Private Circuit End User Links.

Regulation 31(1) of the Electronic Communications Networks and Services Framework Regulations, 2003¹ sets out that, in the event of a dispute, ComReg shall, at the request of either party, initiate an investigation of the dispute and make a determination aimed at resolving the dispute.

Following BT’s withdrawal of its request for Dispute Resolution, ComReg has closed its investigation on the basis that there is no longer a dispute between the parties.
