Potential joint award of spectrum rights of use in the 800 MHz, 900 MHz and 1800 MHz bands

Extension of ComReg Consultation 10/71 Response Period

Following requests received from two interested parties, the Commission for Communications Regulation (ComReg) has today extended the deadline for the submission of responses to its current public consultation on potential joint award of spectrum rights of use in the 800 MHz, 900 MHz and 1800 MHz bands (ComReg Document 10/71) to **5:00 pm, on 29 October 2010**.

This consultation addresses such issues as the expiry of existing GSM 900 MHz licences in May 2011, the potential joint award of the 800 MHz, 900 MHz and 1800 MHz spectrum bands, and consults further on the proposed auction format and proposed licence conditions.

ComReg welcomes the views and comments of all interested parties on the matters raised in ComReg Document 10/71.
