In December 2018¹ ComReg and Eircom agreed a set of commitments which, when fully implemented, will result in the establishment and operation of an enhanced Regulatory Governance Model ("RGM") in Eircom.

As part of this agreement Eircom agreed to create an Independent Oversight Body ("IOB"), which was established in May 2019².

The IOB is charged with, among other things, overseeing and assessing Eircom's regulatory governance arrangements. The IOB consists of five members who will work collaboratively to deliver its mandate. The majority of its members including its Chairperson are independent and appointed by ComReg, with two further members are appointed by Eircom.

Mr Kevin O'Donovan, a ComReg appointee, has resigned his position as a member of the IOB effective from 7 July 2021. ComReg would like to thank him for his commitment to the work of the IOB and the significant contribution he has made to its establishment and operation.

ComReg will appoint a successor in due course.
