## **Three Companies Apply for Fourth 3G Licence**

The Commission for Communications Regulation (ComReg) has announced that, by the deadline for receipt of applications of 12.00 (noon) today 9<sup>th</sup> September 2005, three companies have applied for the fourth 3G mobile licence.

The applications will now be considered by ComReg.

The licence on offer is a so-called 'B' licence to provide 3G mobile services for a period of 20 years. The following is a list of the companies which have submitted tenders (in alphabetical order):

- Eircom
- Meteor Mobile Communications
- Smart Mobile Ltd.

The B licence requires a licensee to provide as a minimum coverage of the five major cities (53%) and somewhat slower minimum roll-out conditions compared with the A licence.

An information memorandum (ComReg 05/41) is available on the ComReg website <u>www.comreg.ie</u>. It describes the objectives of the competition, a description of the licences, the licensing process and framework, fees and timescales.

Three licences for provision of 3G services were issued to '3',  $O_2$  and Vodafone following an earlier competition in 2002.
