Transfer by Eircom Ltd of Third Generation and GSM Mobile Telephony ('3G') Licence

On 26 June 2008, the Commission for Communications Regulation gave its consent to the transfer by Eircom Ltd of its Third Generation and GSM Mobile Telephony ('3G') Licence to Meteor Mobile Communications Ltd, its wholly-owned subsidiary. Consent was given in accordance with Regulation 5(4) of the Wireless telegraphy (Third Generation and GSM Mobile Telephony Licence) Regulations 2003 (S.I. No. 340 of 2003). Eircom Ltd was originally granted its 3G licence in March 2007 and the licence has been assigned to Meteor Mobile Communications Ltd, on a temporary basis, since August 2007. The transfer of the 3G licence took effect on Friday, 27 June 2008.
