

Universal Service Obligation

Application for funding from the Universal Service Provider for the periods 2011/2012 and 2012/2013

- 1. On 31 October 2014, ComReg received two applications for funding for the provision of the universal service from Eircom Limited for the periods 2011/2012 and 2012/2013.
- 2. ComReg wishes to confirm that for the period 2011/2012, Eircom Limited has claimed a net cost of €7.26m including the intangible benefits of €1.97m, for its provision of the universal service, which it is seeking to receive funding for.
- 3. ComReg also wishes to confirm that for the period 2012/2013, Eircom Limited has claimed a net cost of €7.95m including the intangible benefits of €1.80m, for its provision of the universal service which it is seeking to receive funding for.
- 4. In due course, ComReg will begin the process of assessing Eircom Limited's applications for universal service funding in accordance with Decision D04/11.1
- 5. Accordingly, for each application, ComReg will verify if there is a net cost, determine whether or not any such net cost constitutes an unfair burden on Eircom Limited, and decide whether or not to establish a universal service fund.
